17	<b>Hand sanitiser</b> Eg I regularly use hand sanitiser	<i>un d'sînfecteux d'mains</i>
18	<b>Dose</b> Eg I've had my second dose	<i>eune dose</i>
19	<b>Coronavirus</b> Eg The Coronavirus pandemic	Lé coronavirus

31	<b>Outbreak</b> Eg there was an outbreak of Covid	Eune dêcliathâtion
32	<b>Immune</b> Eg she was not immune to the virus	înmeune
33	<b>Immunity</b> Eg He had built up an immunity	L'înmeunité (f)
34	<b>Herd immunity</b> Eg They had a policy of herd immunity	L'înmeunité en fliotchet
35	<b>Furlough</b> Eg He stayed at home on furlough	Lé congî (en congî), lé pèrmission
36	<b>Strain</b> Eg there was a new strain of the virus	La race
